Please excuse the Liberty which I take in addressing you with these lines - as many persons together with myself is desirous of writing our friends in Liberia - will you have the goodness to inform me at what point can we send letters and when to send them to meet that opportunity - we are aware that the next expedition will leave your city on the 1<sup>st</sup> of Nov<sup>r</sup> but perhaps you may be able to inform us of some transient vessel that is up for that place who postally would take letters if nothing else, I hope to make you a small ship next some time in Oct to be forwarded to Liberia, which I would be glad for you to attend to, hoping these few lines may find you well -

please answer at an early day
