Dear Sir

In replying to the memorandum
 this day from Mr John Seys and in
 which he directs me to advise you
 I have to state that Doctor Delay
 died at my house within a mile
 of this place and that the servants
 left free and under my control - and
 that the liabilities for which they are
 responsible will render it necessary
 to hold them in bonds during the
 next year - unless the Society would
 put itself outwards and be willing
 to pay the liability
