To the Editor of the  
Colonization Herald, Baltimore.

Sir.

In the obituary list of the  
Baltimore Patriot, is announced the death of  
John B. Jordan aged 30. on the 7<sup>th</sup> instant.

As there was at that time <sup>in Balt<sup>n</sup></sup> a colored  
man of that age from New Orleans, bearing that  
name on his way to Liberia, I take the liberty  
to ask of Your benevolence in behalf of a poor  
Woman here to send me a list of the passengers  
by the ship advertised to sail for Liberia on the  
present 15<sup>th</sup> of September, if printed in Your paper.

Or, if through the agent for the ship it should  
be quite easy for You to ascertain whether there  
had been an applicant for a passage answering  
to the above description, and if he be the  
person deceased, a letter of advice upon the  
subject, would be a charitable contribution  
in harmony with the beneficent purpose of
