Hagerstown Dec 16th 1852

Dear Sir: About two years since, I said  
to Rev Mr. Soy's that he should have me the  
Colonization Journal sent ~~me~~ one year to Hagers-  
town Md, which he had proposed to do in case of  
the donation of \$1 to the Society also my wife Mrs  
A Markwood, and according to the proposition,  
the Journal, <sup>came</sup> the year out, pretty regularly — and  
since the end of the first year it continues  
to come, about once in every three months,  
and whereas I did not expect it longer than  
to the expiration of the first 12 months and  
from the fact that I am about leaving  
this district of country, I therefore wish you  
to discontinue the Journal to us at present.

P.S. Rev Isaac Statton was to have had  
the Journal also, for 6 months and then it  
discontinue, but it has continued to him about  
every 3 or 4 months, and additionally he is gone  
to Virginia long ago — Stop it to him also;  
his address is also Hagerstown Md. J. M.
