Tuesday.

Dr James Hall.

Sir,

Our emigrant, James Dent, is to come on to this place on tomorrow, or next day at farthest - I will thank you however to keep on the look out for him at the Car Depot until he arrives.

In case he comes on tomorrow, we will start him to Baltimore, bag & baggage, on Thursday - if he comes later, the day after he comes. His baggage I understand will consist of two barrels & a box. Perhaps an extra package (small) may be added here.

Please appoint a proper person to meet him on the coming in of the cars as he may not readily find his way in the city.
