Dear Sir

Please to excuse me
for troubling you on this occasion &
I sent a letter to Mr. Seyes, concerning
My son Cornelius Campbell that
Went in the Ship Panshee to Cape Palmas -
My son forgot some Building Implements
that he wanted & he wrote to me from
Hampton roads to strive to send them on
as soon as a vessel was leaving Balto
for Cape Palmas which he told me he thought
would be about the 30th of this month
So I wrote to Mr. Seyes & got no answer
I thought I would address your honour
hoping that you would let me know
what time a vessel is leaving Balto for
Cape Palmas
