you from any subsequent attacks. -

I have seen Mr. Meier. He was too busy to  
converse with me at the store, and we have  
made arrangements to spend an evening together  
at his place of Board where I shall furnish  
him with news for the Premier writer. -

I have given the Printers my Report for this  
month, designing to add the event of the  
leaving at Westminster on my return. They have  
asked me for a copy for the regular number of the  
Journal and ask for "copy". -
