 package which I sent in your care
 to have forwarded to D M Richardson
 Liberia Africa - I saw from the
 public papers that you were about
 sending a ship to sail on the 18th 1854
 inst. for the coast of Africa - I made
 several efforts to prepare the package
 and have it sent in time to go in the
 said vessel, but my position is such
 that it denied me the opportunity
 of so getting prepared (I am the waiter in
 a Boarding House (and the principal
 part of the attention fall on devolves
 upon me consequently I am necessarily
 much employed.) This being the last day
 I was at a quodway how to get it to
 Baltimore I had it directed per Adams
 express, to whose office I was going
 to send it but fortunately one of our
 Gentlemen - a native of your state, Mr -
 Hunkle - was on his way home, started
 this afternoon, to whom I made the in-
 quiry whether he knew you, he said he
 did not, but in the kindest manner
