Dear Sir I write a line for the  
purpose of inquiring if it be true  
that the Colonization <sup>Ship</sup> leaving Baltimore  
to day is not to go to Cape Palmas.  
Much to our disappointment we  
have no information this morning  
that she will not probably  
go there — We have advised  
the Rev Mr Smith, if this is so,  
not to embark in her, as there  
will be a great uncertainty in  
regard to his getting to Cape Palmas  
from either of the Ports at which  
we understand it is your purpose  
to have the vessel stop —

Will you have the kindness to inform  
me in regard to the determination touching the above  
& those your (very truly) S. D. Simons
