Savannah 24 May 1854
My Dear Sir
I have finally deter-
mined to leave about 25 of
the emigrants, till next vessel.
I telegraphed you that there
would be no vessel hence to
Balt. & the only chance was to
send by the Phil^a. Steamer of the
31 inst. — Since that Mr.
Hines has come & does not want
his people to go by Phil^a. — So I
telegraphed you again to buy
ship to Benson thirty barrels
flour, & twenty to Dennis — M^ok.
A. C. S. — I shall sell that much
here out of the Sophia Walker.
& thus make room for the
things of the emigrants. — I
presume you can fill up
