He now visits Baltimore for the purpose of raising, if possible, \$500 with which to purchase his son, who is also my slave, and whom I cannot afford to part with, without compensation. Any contributions which you may be enabled to obtain for him, for this purpose either from the Colonization Society or from other sources, will be thankfully received by him.
