Dear Sir

Yours of the 29th August
come to hand informing me that on the return
of Dr. Hall to the City you would have the papers put
in proper form and call on me for the legacy to
the Society by the late Mrs P. Duellman - And as a
month has now passed by and not yet having heard from
you - I am led to suppose the matter has escaped your
recollection and I now write you a hasty line to ask
your immediate attention to the same - I am very anxious
to close the Estate and would like very much to make
my settlement with the Orphan Court of Faith County
on this day week and shall be much gratified if you
can arrange your papers so as to receive the out. This
week - It will be necessary to have the acknowledgment
before a Justice of the Peace with the County Seal
a check - I must mention this fact here, because in the
payment of three or four legacies in Ballenon and
New York I have in every case been obliged to return
the papers for that informality to be rectified -
please let me hear from you at your earliest convenience
and much obliged - yours very respectfully
