Dear Doct.

Please find inclosed BK of Wash: check of this date, No. 1680, on Mechanics' BK Balt.: to your order, for one hundred & eight 25/100 dollars, (\$108.25) with which please pay Mr. McLain's note favor of Clark, Luskett & Co., dated Apl. 19, 1855 at Balt.: due the 19th inst. Mr. McLain says, "If you have no bank notice, send it to Dr. Hall, and ask him to pay it." We have no bank notice. It is entered on our bill book, "payable at Col. off. Balt.:" Your kind attention to this will increase our obligations.

I wrote you yesterday, giving you a copy of letter from Rev. T. A. Mills, respecting the result of the negro agency in Indiana in collecting emigrants. Today, I telegraphed you, to say, that Mr. Blodgett has informed us, in letter just received, that the New Jersey emigrants will sail from New York in the N. Y. expedition.

I presume Mr. McLain will be at home from Richmond on Monday, if not this evening. You may, therefore, expect him in Balt. on Tuesday—possibly Monday.
