My Dear Sir

Mr. Seyes accepts. We have
had answer this morning. He says
he will be ready to enter the work April 1
I will raise all the money possible
& think \$2,000 must be his salary
with expenses. — So that is fixed.

Our houses will be ready
in time. — The N. Y. Soc. have agreed
that we shall draw on the Howland
fund for the 104 persons, we ask them
for — not to exceed \$5,000 — Our list
looks now at 250 to 300.

Shall we charter in Boston,
or get the houses brought to Balt. in one of
the steamers? — When shall we set Mr.
Seyes to work? We have no good state open.
The state Soc. control them all — Thus,
other matters fill our minds —
