We will take Mrs. Sharpe on  
the terms you propose — if your Soc.  
will not agree to any other. So you  
may consider it certain that they  
shall go. I will do the same. I  
should think you three agents could raise the  
money! — I cannot tell exactly when  
we shall bring up — whether in one ship, or  
two — & how!
