Your favor is before me - In reply I will say that Savannah is the most convenient & accessible point for the embarkation of Mrs Shamp's family. Winchester is within three miles of the main rail road line from Nashville to Savannah, & she is near Winchester.

You express surprise that she should not be able to furnish all the means requisite to send away her servants. Were she absolutely to impoverish herself & throw herself, in her old age, upon the public for support, the amount might be furnished by her. But would this be right? I am ~~not~~ sure that the sacrifice she proposes to make is not greater than duty demands.
