Dr James Ball, Winchester Ten April 7th 1856

Dear Sir, I received your letter, of the first of March, on the fifth of this inst, which gave me great relief of mind, I hope you will be as favourable with me, as possible, I also hope you will not leave, without taking my folks, which will be about 43 in number, 9 men, 3 boys, 10 women, 8 girls, the balance, children, as to the difference of cost from here to the two ports you named, I cannot say, if I have to send them to the port, I think it will be the most convenient, to send them to Savannah Ga, I wish some, ~~inform~~ information, in regard to who is to take them from here, and how the business is to be arranged.
