Dear Sir,

Upon further reflection, as the Steamer from Balt^o will not call here for Kelley's Slaves, we think it will be unnecessary to take them to Balt^o, thence to Norfolk as we are now within 70 or 80 Miles of the latter place, and can send them down direct from this place by a private vessel.

As you will send the emigrants from Balt^o by the regular line, of course you will not have to charter a vessel expressly for the purpose. You will please advise us as soon as possible on what day we should have ours in Norfolk and we will have them there.
