The Elvira Owen has not arrived in Hampton Roads — But the wires are in good repair now between here and Petersburg. Should the ship come tonight or tomorrow you shall hear of it by Telegraph. In that case I will write to you by the Monday evening boat also.

Messrs. Hall & Meredith say, Bring the stores when you come — and if they shall have left here before you reach the ship they will have the cash with me for you.

Wind is N.E. here, and has been ever since Thursday afternoon. Hope the ship will soon be here.
