I made sit down to write you these few
lines to inform you that I receive a letter from my mother
Margret Douglass of Chancelston that she had sent on 40 -
Dolans on to you to be sent on to me and a key I receive
a barrel but no money nor key nor any ill say that he have
not receive it she write to me it was to be sent on in god
an silace and as it had not come on you will oblige me to send it
on in provisions I want the most Bread stuff

Such as flour and hard bread

and meal and a little bacon

and soap if the money will

about it to be bought

you will oblige me to send them on and take the freight money
out them and perhaps my mother or some one else may send on
more more after a while to William Douglass of Sineo I am
the one and you can get provision in that but the articles
will be man to you when the money comes
