My Dear Sir

Yours of yesterday is received. I have been looking for you - sitting at the door & windows at the coming in of the two evening trains for three days - & have been disappointed each time. Dr. Sinclair has been down the last two evenings waiting for you - and now "ho & behold" you are not coming at all! That is too bad! - for an all over day!

And now for the business part of your letter - I do want to settle up - so far at least as to know exactly the expenses & receipts of the shipment by the Elvira Owen - about which I have been for several days writing up the accounts.
