Dear Sir,

Your note containing Dr Wall's inquiry, is before me -

I do not advise any paint, or coating, applied to the water tanks, as nothing permanent has been discovered.

The best way of treating them & the water is the follg.

When finished let them be well scrubbed with ordinary lime white wash, to remove every trace of oil, or paint, from the interior & after standing one, or two days, they may be washed out to receive the water.
