Their family of Gross' went out in 49 or 50 I think -

The last accounts I have rec^d & informed me they were living at Cape Palmas - Thomas engaged in teaching a school in the country 15 miles from his residence. His school was connected with the Meth['] Epis['] Mission, supported I suppose by 'em. The pupils were natives of course. I heard with regret that Thomas was
