Dear Sir

I met Mr. Coppinger
to day and asked him whether he thought
you would purchase a Barrel of Prime
Pork and a keg of Good Butter to be
consigned to Mr. Henry M. West, Phila.
and a Silecia (the same person to whom
I sent goods in your last expedition
from Baltimore, and he said he had
no doubt you would as you had done
where you purchased such goods, now
Sir if you would I would be much obliged
to you. You can send me the cost, also
the freight and I will transmit it
to you immediately. The bill of lading,
you might retain, as I may ~~send~~
send some few little articles from Phila.
by Adams Express, after which you might
forward it to me as I shall have the goods
insured. Should you ~~desire~~ ^{the funds before purchasing} let me know
the cost as above and I will forward it
to you. If I purchase here I shall have
the expense of forwarding them to Baltimore
by doing you will much oblige
