Resolved, That the Executive Committee be authorized
to have a Steamer constructed of about 70 Tons
burthen, at a cost of not exceeding Ten thousand
Dollars; and that said Committee be instructed
to make a special appeal to the friends of the Cause,
for aid, to the extent of Five thousand dollars,

also
Resolved That the Parent Society, be invited
to cooperate in the above.

Resolved, That other State Societies, be also invited to
unite with us in the same.
