Our last receipt was for Sch  
M. Sheppard, May 15 via Liverpool. We have letters of  
the same date from the "Palmas" then at Sinoe bound down, had on  
board 12,000 Gall. Palm Oil - we know that 5000 Gall. will be del.  
by Rock at Cape Palmas, and there should be enough Oil ready at  
Bassa to make up 27,000 Gall. - Oil will deliver from the "Hall"  
if it is needed, and we can complete the lading of the Brig with  
Oil & Wood that we have on hand here - We think that she  
should leave this coast some time next month.

The "Mendi" arrived out ten days ago, bring no letters from you,  
the "Sivens" is reported to be at Cape Mount.
