Smith were offered to her husband at 25% advance on Invoice, he only desired to take part of them, we declined, so they remain on hand. Orders not ready to pay for Tom Stone. Jones has only made settlement for Gellows and Linda Stone within the last week. It will be best to let all orders from here have our approval hereafter.

We hand Cap. Morgan samples of Tom Coffee from Bales 174. 175, they do not open according to samples furnished with the goods.

Regatta Prints. Patterns excellent, large & medium sized figures preferred: the quality of the fabric, and the price should be uniform, they are used for native trade by purchasers, with whom "piece by piece" fine or coarse, if not too coarse. Uniformity in prices, with variety of patterns - pink color should predominate.

Wadder Prints. Larger figures in the pattern, textures & price to be uniform.

Romals, do well enough, they are about as poor as they need be. Iron Pots, as you will observe by reference to sales go off slowly for the reason stated in former letters - send us no more of them. We have faced them in parties below.

We shall charge you with whatever we may have to pay as storage on Crochery & Iron Pots for which we could not make room.
