My dear Sir, T A 25-

I have your  
note of yesterday & at once reply  
that Liberia has nothing to do  
with our contracts but as they  
respect the Recaptives after being  
landed: The vote to appropriate  
at once all the money received  
from the last years appropriation  
by Congress, was by me and  
I think by the Committee  
only designed to authorize  
the use of it even where we  
had a perfect property in it  
to meet the present pressing  
great demand for means  
required by the contract  
of the 2300 poor boys and  
until Congress shall make  
another appropriation.
