Mr Charles Howard Dear friend after being  
from you and here two years I write you  
a few lines to let you know that we are all  
well at this moment hoping that you are  
the same we left your good City for our  
new home and after a voyag of 31. thirty  
one days lande in this place we built our  
house and improved the land that we loan  
by building our house 22 by 18 feet a rock base  
ment a pier place below and above we have  
abought one hundred and fifty feet all of  
which are rock so you see the pier cant not  
burn it and now what I want to say to you  
Pleas to release us from the Debt of fifty dollar  
no. which you let Mr gibson have towards build  
ing our house and now my Dear friend if  
you do so think that you can without doing  
your self harm please to help us that much  
it will be a grate help to us. I have seen  
Doctor hall and Mr gibson and asked them  
the same now Dear friend help us a little  
and the good Lord will bless you I am now  
king at my wheel right bussness with  
good succes give our to Mr george W. hall  
and all friends write to us as soon as you  
git this My wife and Children all join  
in love to you no more But remains yours
