to be due, and that yourself and
Dr. ^{Pinner} ~~Half~~ acting in conjunction
with Mr Mc Lain may accom-
plish the end we have in
view.

The President hopes it may be

Dr. Pinner to take an interest
in the matter and communicate
to me in the premises by first
Mail via England.

If we can receive advices
from the U. S. in November
that a portion of the last install-
ment has been paid, and that
our drafts will be honored,
