

still in our own hands, our Board ^{now} ~~is~~
the only party authorized to determine
what these expenditures should
have been. and that all that the Li-
berian Government is authorized to
demand from us, is simply to differ-
ence between what our agents did
actually expend, & what they received
from the Government of the U. States.
I have not time to say more, but
will probably write to you again in
a few days, & also to Mr. Crozier.
