At the request of Mrs Miller's mother I represented to the Pres: Bd. For Missions her case, & Dr Loring replied to me that the Board would make up the sum \$100 in gold for which I was informed that she could be brought out with her children. This I will guarantee, but I am not authorised to go further, though I have no doubt that the Board would add 'a small amount if charged'. Or if you think it best, I will write Mr Loring to confer directly with the Colonization Soc^y in New York.
