My Dear Sir;

The "Solconda" left
this port on the night of the 25. of last
month direct for Baltimore. I promised
in my letter by her to send you by this month's
mail an acct of some disbursements
&c, which you will find here with
enclosed. You will see there is a
balance against the ship of \$140.89
I omitted in my receipt to the Captain
for surplus stores landed, to
include two bbls of white Beans that
were also landed. Please note them.
I delivered him twelve (12) boxes of
the upper ten coffee that were landed
as surplus stores from the last
