My dear Sir

I inclose you three lists of medicines, with quantities, marks etc. specified.

I inclose list of provisions which want for 400 full persons. You will please lay in water & food for that number for the passage. There will be from 600 to 650 old & young, you will arrange spoons, cups etc. accordingly.

I inclose list of goods etc. for paying general expenses - all in this list to be marked H. W. Dennis

I inclose names of merchants who will take half cash - & half in our notes for what we purchase of them.

The quantity of each kind of meats, & bread stuff are put down as I would make them if the market allowed. I authorize you to change when any article cannot be had at a proper price. I hope you can get Rice, Sugar & Molasses in Bond.

The migrants are to be landed - say 250 at Bassa - 250 at Simon
