I have deposited with me twenty nine dollars (\$29) for the purpose of bringing Aaron Tillman (son of Batham Tillman Dec<sup>d</sup>.) who will be 11 years old on the 11<sup>th</sup> May 1868, from Liberia to Baltimore on the return voyage of the Colconda in August or September.

The mother of Aaron Tillman is in the country - Her name is Pietta Wright (formerly owned by Chalmers).

Shall I send the money to you in a draft, so that there may be no delay about the matter, or shall I make the arrangement with some house in Baltimore - or shall I do this through Dr. Jas. Hall (is it James or Joseph) of Baltimore? Let me know and I will attend to it punctually. Truly yours
