Dear Sir

I send to-day, by Hamden's, two boxes for Liberia, which please forward by the "Golconda". One is for H. W. Dennis Esq, and contains newspapers, pamphlets, files of the Repository &c for sundry Liberians; and the other is addressed to Mr Henry Tyler, Clay-Ashland. We prepay the charges to Baltimore. As the bot for Mr Dennis contains mail matter only, it ought to be delivered to him free of freight.

Has Capt Lovett arrived? At what wharf does the ship lay, and about what hour on Wednesday do you expect to get her off?
