Doctor James Hall.

Very Dear Sir

Your letter of date 28 April 1868 was received in regard to the purport of which was that Mr McLean informed you that Mr Dennis by Genl Spent A.C.S. complained that I denied him the privilege of storing the Society's effects in the warehouse, in consequence of my having claims on the Society etc etc.

I must confess that while you were surprised at such conduct as that in my part, I was misled as such news was the case and there has been no other place used for that purpose since the Golemda has been coming here bringing immigrants, but Mr Dennis N.W. says to me that he did not make that report. Now Doctor I tell you candidly what may have given rise to that base fabrication Elijah H.A. Dennis nephew to Mr Dennis suggested to me some time ago to repair the store for which he held a claim on it to that I refused - he having been carrying on business in it as Commissioned Merchant when not acting for the A.C.S. as clerk.
