Dear Sir

The ship
"Golconda" is now going to sea
with fair prospect of a fine
run off. having had several
days detention in getting out
of the river the Tugboats had
hold of her three times before
they succeeded to tow her to
Swan Point. The ship remains
tight and I have a first-rate
crew I therefore anticipate no trouble
making the voyage across
the Atlantic. nothing further
at present but trusting to have
a quick and safe passage
