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On and after December the 1st we shall conduct the Astor House on the European Plan. Its location offers great inducements to the traveling business community; all the city railroads converging at the Hotel—the Ferries in its immediate vicinity—taking them without delay to the neighboring manufacturing cities, or to their business appointments.

The scale of prices for rooms will be found extremely moderate, being governed by location.

The Restaurant Department will be carried on liberally. The delicacies of the season can be obtained at all hours.

The reputation of the house for superiority in its cuisine and as a Home for Travelers, will be maintained and if possible excelled.
