Hall of 2 July 1870. I regret that you
should have put this matter off
until the present time, as Dr.
Hall has just left for St. Ermi, & the
Capt. & officers of the Golconda
who understand the case
have lately sailed for Siberia.
Our understanding of the facts
in dispute & the usages of
the port, constrain us to believe
that the Golconda is not bound
in justice to pay the claim you
make. Dr. Hall has been en-
trusted with the management of the
ship & her affairs, & we must therefore beg
you to let the matter lie over until his return.
