

Philadelphia May 4th 1857.
Dr. James Hall. 47
Dear Sir— After
Congratulating You on the safe
return of yourself & daughter,
and the entire satisfaction that
Mr. Wilson informs me You have at
the vessel. (Mr. W. says she is an
admirable Sailer.)— I wish to
inquire after a package of Daguerres,
which President Benson informs
me he sent to You. The Governor
& several Senators have all sent
me their daguerrotypes for likeness,
as the President says, and would not
like to treat them with so much
disrespect as to have them knocking
about some office or Custom House.
