Dear Sir,

I am of opinion that it would not affect your compliance as a witness to sign as being on the Bond. - Still - to save any question that might be raised, it would no doubt be better, if convenient, to have other names on the Bond than those of yourself & son - In case you have other parties who will sign, it would be better not to have your own names appear.

After <sup>the</sup> signing of the Appeal Bond no further steps can be taken on the other side, except at their peril.

I have seen the officer, who says that Warrington directed execution to issue, but no writ has as yet been placed in his hands, nor is it likely that anything will be done to day.
