Yours of the 8th came duly.

to him that we would do what was right
& liberal - and that we should doubtless
submit the matter to your decision,
as to what that would be - if he had no
objections thereto - that we could not
say now - as we did not yet know how
much you had charged ft. - or whether
you had charged for delay in Balt.
for the mill - nor how long the ship
be delayed at Monrovia.

We gave you two notes for insurance
on the ship - one for 2,803.50 date 12 Nov. 1856
& one for 411.25 date 3 Dec. 1856 - both at 6 mos.
which you have doubtless endorsed over
to the insurers - & the payment of which
