I have just received a letter from home stating that they have nothing for me at the present time and I am sorry, for I really expected to be able to have paid you for my passage before the vessel set sail again but just be kind enough, ~~and~~ if you cant wait on me untill in the spring take the property that is in Liberia and have it sold to pay the debt for it was necessity drove me here and now I am in Philadelphia and have no money to take me on horse back of the mountains to Pittsburg so I am going to hire out to work, I am with hope you are no more remains yours respectfully ~~Samuel~~
