Yours of the 20th is received - it was waiting for me last night - our Ex. Com. met & transacted some business. The Messrs. Case Brothers owe us \$16,000.00 due the 26th - we only asked them for \$6,000.00 - they not having the "ready red" - offer us Alex.^a Cor.^r Note which Dr. Hinton says any of the Banks in Baltimore will discount readily. We shall have to renew the \$10,000 -

You may I think make yourself easy about that \$5,000.00 note of 15 Dec. - as there is no doubt we ought to pay it & take the Securities I believe you & I think we can.

I cannot come over before Tuesday - & may be detained till Wednesday. In that case, let me say the chief of my things are on that list I gave you. The balance are bought at Sillman's
