for a bbl of Seed rice & 10th Hops
the Hops packed in the bbl of Rice
I sent by Cromwells line, rec^d herewith
Please receive it & ship it by the Stevens
& send me ac^t of expense with that of
the wood - I directed it to be sent to
your care, but notice the name "James
Hunter" on the rec^d - Yours truly
