Dear Sir

I wrote to J. C. Manning  
 with Hopkins & Hull for a bill of  
 goods to be sent to Liberia to  
 my niece and nephew I wanted  
 them to go in the first vessel  
 sailing to that port I received  
 a letter from Messrs Hopkins  
 & Hull demanding a check  
 for amount in which they  
 stated that they could not  
 get the goods off the package  
 could not be very large and  
 I think might have been  
 shipped if proper attention
