My Dear Sir.

Your of 26 & 28 both
came this evening. I regret
that I omitted to tell you all
about what we get or expect to
pay. It was an oversight. each

We expect to get \$50. for
one living when our ships
receive them at Key West. We
have to make ^{room} for the whole number
alive when the Secy. last heard
from there, 1.033. The Secy. of
fered us \$50. each for carrying
them to Liberia. We ask \$150. each
for supporting them there one year.
I think Congress will pass it.

I do not intend to pay
more than \$12,000 for a ship to
carry 500 but I may finally
be compelled to do so. One had been
