My Dear Sir

Yours of 29th is received. I wrote you twice yesterday. I go to N. Y. at 3.20 day.

I am sorry to say another slave has been captured taken to Key West, with 420 Africans, and I have contracted to take them. Awful! But I cannot help it! — A Mr. Wilson from your city has been here & offered to take them at \$40.00 each!
