My Dear Sirs,

I have this moment received
a letter from Mr. Tracy. He says "Mr.
Cowans House is on the wharf - goes
on board tomorrow. The 3rd sails the
4th & reaches Port. The 9th 1200
Cubic feet is a liberal allowance
of space for it in the ship. You
will therefore look out for it - & put
it aboard. It is to be landed at
Monrovia.

We have dates to 28 Aug. at
Mon. & some of our ships there then!
He says "Mr. Sit. has made certain ac-
quisitions of him which he could not dan-
not comply with. The correspondence
was kept up until a filing has been crea-
ted which I fear will be disastrous. My
own course has been in perfect ac-
cordance with the letter and spirit of the
instructions from my Govt. & from this course
